WAYS OF GIVING TO SAMS

1. Gift Aid Declaration

For all income tax payers and/or capital gains tax payers who wish to give to SAMS tax effective donations of any amount, via cheques, standing orders etc.

2. Direct Gift

Please send cheques, postal orders etc, made payable to 'SAMS' to the SAMS office in Tunbridge Wells (address overleaf).

3. Bank Deposit

Cash or cheques can be paid via Bank Giro into the SAMS account at the Bank of Scotland, Sort Code 12-12-68, Account no. 00871727. We can supply transfer slips if required.

4. Alliance and Leicester (Girobank Transfer)

Cash or cheques can be transferred directly to the SAMS Girobank Account No. 547 2008 from any Post Office or from your own A&L account.

5. Banker's Order in favour of SAMS.

If you want to give amounts on a regular basis e.g. monthly or quarterly, write to us for a Banker's Order Form.

6. Payments to SAMS via the internet

e.g. via www.givenow.org or see www.AllAboutGiving.org

7. A Gift Via Your Local Church

You can give your gift to your local SAMS secretary or your PCC treasurer and they will forward it to us.

8. A Gift of Listed Shares and Securities to SAMS

A very tax-effective way of giving to charity.

9. Payroll Giving

For anyone who is employed and wishes to give tax-effectively by payroll deduction. Arranged through your employer.

10. Interest-Free Loan

If there are amounts of money that could be lent to SAMS, free of interest, this assists cash flow and certain areas of ministry considerably. SAMS would undertake to refund it to you, either at a certain future date or on demand.

11. Legacy

Remembering SAMS in your Will is a very valuable way of supporting the work of the Society. In all but the most exceptional of circumstances a bequest to SAMS would be exempt from Inheritance Tax.

12. Use of Charitable Accounts such as those offered by Charities Aid Foundation (CAF) (using a CAF Voucher or CAF Charity Card) or Stewardship Services

If you have an account you can use it to give to SAMS.

13. SAMS Mission Boxes

Putting your notes and coins in one of these will see them accumulate for SAMS. Available from the office.

14. Giving Used Stamps for SAMS

These can raise money for SAMS. Our leaflet 'Stamps for SAMS' gives details.

15. Selling your heirlooms

Thousands of pounds may be lying around in unused and unwanted possessions. Please send your "treasures" clearly marked for SAMS to: the Hon.

Chairman, Wallington Missionary Auctions, 20 Dalmeny Road, Carshalton, Surrey SM5 4PP. All auctions are conducted by professional auctioneers and valuers.

16. Selling Goods for SAMS

SAMS stock a small range of goods for sale (e.g. videos, books, CDs and tapes). An increase in the sale of these assists SAMS' finances.

17. Organising Sponsored Events

Walks, marathons, swims, etc. You could auction your youth group members off to work by the hour for the highest bidder!

18. Encouraging Companies to Give to SAMS

As SAMS is a Registered Charity those who play a part in company decisions could consider SAMS as a possible beneficiary of a charitable gift.

19. Higher Rate Taxpayers

If you pay tax at a higher rate, greater tax relief can be achieved via your tax return.

20. Tax Overpayment

Those who overpay their tax can ask the Inland Revenue to send the overpayment to SAMS via their Self-Assessment tax return. The unique code for SAMS to benefit is *GAE91JG*.
